Greenville, SC— Impressionism, the first bombshell launched against academic tradition, defined light as color, becoming the first modern language of paint. This selection of American Impressionist paintings from the GCMA collection invites viewers to consider the ideas and techniques that opened the door to modern visual expression.

The works highlighted in the exhibition ***From Cassatt to O’Keeffe*** illuminate the role of American artists in the international Impressionist movement, from the 1880s through the 1920s, and its influence on subsequent modernist developments of the period such as Pointillism, Fauvism, and Cubism.

The Greenville County Museum of Art is located in the center of downtown Greenville’s cultural campus, Heritage Green, at 420 College Street. The GCMA is open Wednesday through Saturday from 10 am until 5 pm and on Sundays from 1 pm until 5 pm. Admission is free. To learn more, visit gcma.org/see
